

1. Parties involved and object of agreement

Cuisine Creative GmbH provides catering and banquet services to its clients. Each agreement is based on an individual arrangement made with the customer as well as the below stated general terms and conditions.

The client of Cuisine Creative remains host of the event (or a person placed in charge by the client). The host is responsible for the general operational succession of the event and time keeping. Cuisine Creative cannot be made liable for the client's responsibilities.

2. Formation of a contract

Cuisine Creative submits a proposal to its client. The final, detailed quotation is based on this proposal. After having assessed the quotation, during which any requested changes and amendments can be made, a confirmation of order is sent to the client. The confirmation of order is a binding contract upon the client's signing of the document.

3. Infrastructure

The client (or a chosen person in charge) guarantees that the necessary amenities (esp. water, electricity, etc.) are functioning and that access to the location is secured. Should any of the above terms not be guaranteed it is the client's responsibility to inform Cuisine Creative as soon as possible, in any case, before the signing of the confirmation of order (see point 2. above).

The client (or a chosen person in charge) must ensure liability charges are covered by the correct insurance policy for the event (injury to persons, property damage, etc.).

The client (or a chosen person in charge) must have the correct permit from local authorities should he/she wish to prolong the event beyond the legally permitted closing times.

Cuisine Creative will charge corkage should the client or any third party bring beverages to the event.

4. Subsequent changes of contract

Any changes of contract (food and/or beverages) must be communicated 8 calendar days prior to the date the event takes place. We cannot make allowances for any later changes. The client must inform Cuisine Creative (in writing) of any changes in the number of participants at least 48 hours before the event takes place. Any belated changes will be subsequently charged.

5. Cancellation fees

In the case of cancellation, Cuisine Creative will charge as follows:

14 days before the event	no charge
13-8 days before the event	30% of cancelled services
7-3 days before the event	50% of cancelled services
2-0 days before the event	100% of cancelled services

6. Payment / down-payment

Full payment must be made at least 20 days after date of invoice. In case of delay of payment Cuisine Creative reserves the right to charge an additional 5% of the amount invoiced. If catering for a large party or banquet, Cuisine Creative reserves the right to request a down-payment of up to 50% of the final invoice.

7. Applicable Law and Place of Jurisdiction

The terms and conditions according to Swiss Law are applicable. Exclusive place of jurisdiction is Zürich. The client agrees to resign his right to choose his place of jurisdiction, whether at his place of residence or elsewhere.
